- As announced last Sunday, we have received directions on the restarting of public Masses. After consulting with staff, I'm happy to announce that we will resume daily Masses on Monday, May 11, at Noon. Our Sunday Masses will resume on May 16-17. Masses are limited to 75 people. In order to accommodate these numbers, we are adding two temporary Sunday Masses. And so, our weekend Mass schedule will be Saturday's at 4 PM and 5:30 PM and Sunday's at 7 AM, 9 AM, 11 AM, and 12:30 PM. *The Bishop's dispensation is still in effect. If you are not comfortable coming to Mass, you are dispensed.* Our live stream service will continue for our daily Masses and our 11 AM Sunday Mass. Please consult our parish website for more information.
- With the addition of new Masses during this transitional period, we will have space for new Mass intentions. I ask that these intentions be reserved for those who have died from Covid-19. I know that several of our parishioners have lost loved ones from this virus. Please reach out to Natalie Jackson with names and information (njackson@charlestdioocese.org).
