- The charitable portion of our tithes this week will go to the diocesan Seminary Collection. This fund assists in covering the educational and formational needs of our future priests! Please remember our seminarians in your prayers.
- The flowers in the sanctuary are in honor of Al and Kay Herold's 55th Wedding Anniversary. Happy Anniversary!
- This weekend is Corpus Christi. At the Bishop's request, we are offering a few quiet moments of Adoration and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament after our 11:00 AM Mass today. In these devotions, we are asking God for the restoration of public health and for a greater harmony among all races and peoples.
- We are now back to our regular, permanent Mass schedule: Saturday evenings at 4:00 PM and 5:30 PM and Sunday mornings at 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM. The number of worshippers will be increased to 85 per Mass. With the quarantine still in effect, we will preserve our custom of celebrating Mass *ad orientem*. Once things stabilize further, this custom will be reevaluated.
- Some parishioners have inquired about our First Friday Masses, Nocturnal Adoration, and First Saturday Masses. In light of the work that's currently being done to stabilize our regular liturgical schedule, we have to suspend these observances until October.
- As a help to understanding the multiple twists and turns of our current time, I'm launching a new show on Grace Lily. The show will air Monday – Thursday at 4:00 PM. It will be 20-30 minutes in length. The first show is this Monday, June 15.
