As a help to your holiday planning, our <u>Masses for Christmas</u> will be celebrated on December 24 at 4 PM, 6 PM, and 8 PM, as well as on December 25 at 10 AM. *All of the Christmas Masses will be livestreamed*. The church building will only be opened 30 minutes before each respective Mass. Due to safety restrictions relating to the pandemic, we will not have the children's choir or children's homily at the Masses this year. As usual, our Masses are limited to 125 people on a first-come, first-served basis.

Some things happening around the parish:

In honor of Christmas and the New Year, please note our <u>Parish Schedule for</u> <u>December 28 - 31</u>. The church building and Parish Office will be closed on Monday, December 28, and on Wednesday – Thursday, December 30 - 31. No public Masses will be offered on these days.

Tuesday, December 29, is the only day next week that will be on a regular schedule. Daily Mass will be offered on that day.

Please note our <u>Mass Schedule for Mother of God</u>. On Thursday, December 31, we'll have Mass at 4 PM and 5:30 PM. On Friday, January 1, we'll have Mass at 9 AM and 11 AM. Confessions will be offered after every holy day Mass.

On Monday, January 4, our regular parish schedule resumes.
