Some things happening around the parish:

Due to the vigil of the Immaculate Conception, we will not have a Noon Mass or Confessions on Tuesday, December 7.

This Wednesday, December 8, is the solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. It is a holy day of obligation. Masses are Tuesday evening at 4:00 PM and 5:30 PM and Wednesday at 9:00 AM, 11:00 AM, and 7:00 PM. *Before each Mass*, parishioners will have an opportunity to make (or review) their Consecration to Jesus through Mary. *After each Mass* (other than the 7:00 PM), Confessions will be available.

Please note that our 7:00 PM Mass on December 8 is also our Anniversary Mass as a formal parish. In commemoration of our anniversary, we'll conclude the Mass with a bagpipe, candlelight procession to Our Lady's statue and crown her the Queen of our parish!

Our parish Bible Study, High School Formation Program, and Middle School Formation Program are all on hiatus until Wednesday, January 12.

For your future planning, I'll be away on vacation from Monday-Wednesday, December 13-15. There are no Confessions or daily Masses on these days. All our devotions, the Rosary, and our Adoration time will still take place.
