Happy Sunday, Team Grace!

We are now in the holy season of Lent. It is a sacred time of renewal. We are called to evaluate our discipleship and declare our love for the Lord Jesus. Do not let anything distract you. Keep your focus on the Lord Jesus and on the reliving of his Paschal Mystery every day.

During Lent, please note that the Church takes on certain penitential practices: the color violet is used; the “Gloria” at the beginning of Mass is paused; the “Alleluia” is suspended throughout the Mass; flowers and festive music are halted; and, here at our parish, we reduce our altar candles from six to two. All of these are external reminders to us of the purpose and goal of Lent.

This weekend, Monsignor Karl Chimiak continues to assist with our parish Masses. It’s a blessing to have a retired priest helping us here at the parish!

Here are some things happening at the parish this week:

This weekend in the narthex, we have sign-ups for our Nocturnal Adoration next Friday and Saturday, March 3-4. Please be generous with your time and give an hour of prayer to the Lord and your parish family.

Our Stations of the Cross for Lent will be held on Mondays at 7:00 PM. The Stations will begin this Monday, February 27. All are welcome!

We pray for the young people of the parish who will be away for the Diocesan Youth Conference on March 4-5.

This Friday evening, March 3, at 7:00 PM, we have our monthly Mass of the Sacred Heart. Confessions will follow the Mass and continue until Midnight.

This Saturday morning, March 4, at 11:00 AM, we have our monthly Healing Mass with the Anointing of the Sick. All in need of the sacrament are encouraged to come. Starting in March, we will have a free brunch after the Healing Mass.
