Next weekend, July 29-30, the parish is happy to welcome a priest of <u>FOCUS</u> to celebrate and preach our weekend Masses. FOCUS is the Church's outreach to Catholic college and university students. Many of you might remember our last visit by a FOCUS priest. It's been a little while, and so it's good to host another FOCUS priest and be reminded of the Church's extensive outreach and efforts to minister to Catholic young people in the college and university systems of our country.

While we host a FOCUS priest here at the parish, I'll be away speaking at the <u>Defending the Faith conference</u> at the Franciscan University of Steubenville.
