This coming Friday, August 4, we will have our monthly Mass of the Sacred Heart at 7:00 PM. Confessions will follow the Mass and continue until Midnight.

This coming Saturday, August 5, we will have our monthly Healing Mass with the Anointing of the Sick at 11:00 AM. Confessions will precede the Mass from 9:00 AM - 10:30 AM. Our prayer teams and parish brunch will follow the Mass. All are welcome!

I'd like to encourage every household of the parish to register for <u>FORMED</u>. This is a free digital platform with good Catholic, family-friendly content. I also want to

strongly encourage every household to join <u>EWTN OnDemand</u>, which is another free digital platform whose content is supportive of our faith.

Some other future events I'd like to highlight:

On August 12-13, the parish will host a School Supply Drive. All school supplies are needed. Please bring popular school supplies with you to Mass that weekend. You can drop off any items at the pavilion before Mass. Members of our Helping Hands ministry will be there to assist you.

On Sunday, August 13, the parish will once again host two blood buses. I ask that all parishioners please consider giving blood. As a pro-life people this is one of the important things we're called to do! Please do what you can. Sign-ups are required. You can sign up here.

The Solemnity of Our Lady's Assumption, August 15, is a Holy Day of Obligation. Our Masses here will be on Monday, August 14, at 4:00 PM, 5:30 PM, and 7:00 PM, and Tuesday, August 15, at 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM. Confessions will follow after each Mass.

On the weekend of August 19-20, the parish will host a <u>display on the Eucharistic Miracles</u>. After all the Masses that weekend, parishioners are invited to visit the Parish Hall and peruse the display. The miracles can be a great help to deepening our belief in the Lord's True Presence in the Eucharist.

In observance of Labor Day, September 4, the parish campus will be closed. There is no public Mass or Confessions on that day. All other events are suspended.

On Friday, September 8, the parish will be hosting a one-day visit to Belmont Abbey. I've spoken about the witness and prayer routine of the monks before. This visit will be an opportunity to see it in person! Details are still being worked out. More information is forthcoming.
