## Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

- This weekend marks our new weekend worship schedule:

**Saturday at 4:00 PM: Solemn Vespers**

**Sunday at 7:30 AM, 9:00 AM, and 11:00 AM: Holy Mass**

- The All Souls envelopes are for you to formally ask your local pastor to prayerfully remember your beloved dead through the next year. It is very important that you write the names of your loved ones on the envelopes. Please note: the All Souls collection goes directly to the priest. This is the only time in which collected funds go directly to the priest.
- Starting this Tuesday, November 5, we will start having public weekly devotional prayers at the Holy Angels Columbarium at 9:30 AM. We will also start to have Morning Prayer (Lauds) of the Liturgy of the Hours at 10:00 AM in the church. All are welcome and encouraged to come!
- Also this Tuesday, November 5, is the start date for our thirty-three days of preparation for the Consecration to Jesus through Mary. If you want to make (or renew) the Consecration on December 8, you'll need to begin the preparation this Tuesday.
- The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has called for a Jubilee of Hope in the year 2025. The last Jubilee was in the year 2000. The next one after 2025 will be in 2050.
