- Please note that we are entering Holy Week. All the faithful are invited to participate in the sacred liturgies of this holiest week of the year!
- During Holy Week, our parish schedule is very different. The full breakdown of the week's schedule can be found in the Pastor's Column and on the public calendar on our website. Here are some of the highlights:
- There are no public Mass or Confessions this Tuesday, April 15, since I'll be in Charleston for the Chrism Mass with our Bishop.
- There is no Noon Mass this Thursday, April 17, since the Mass of the Lord's Supper is in the evening at 7:00 PM. Adoration and Confessions are from 8:30 PM until 11:50 PM.
- On Good Friday, April 18, Confessions begin at 9:00 AM and continue until 8:00 PM (with a stop for the Liturgy of the Lord's Passion). The Liturgy of the Lord's Passion is at 3:00 PM.
- The Great Easter Vigil is on Saturday night, April 19, at 8:30 PM. A Resurrection Party follows the Easter Vigil.
- Our Easter Sunday Mass schedule is our regular Sunday Mass schedule: 7:30 AM, 9:00 AM, and 11:00 AM.
