- The flowers in the sanctuary this weekend are in memory of Jim Mitchell. *May he rest in peace!*
- As we enter the month of the dead, the Book of the Dead is now placed by the baptismal font. Everyone whose name is written in the Book of the Dead will be remembered during the sacred liturgies throughout November.
- This afternoon, at 12:30 PM, we'll have our annual Blessing of Niches at the Holy Angels Columbarium. Everyone is invited to the blessing, especially those who have loved ones resting in the columbarium.
- This weekend, we have sign-ups for our Nocturnal Adoration this coming Friday and Saturday, November 7-8. Please be generous with your time and give an hour of prayer to the Lord and your parish family.
- The annual diocesan Priest Retreat will be held on November 4-6. All the priests of the diocese will be with the Bishop on retreat. As such, there will be no public Masses and no Confessions starting Monday evening (November 3) and then from Tuesday through Thursday, November 4-6. All of our parish devotionals – Lauds, Adoration, the holy Rosary, Vespers, etc. – will remain the same, *except for the afternoon devotionals being prayed at 12 Noon and our afternoon Adoration times starting earlier (around 12:10 PM).*
