Second Sunday of Advent

December 7, 2025

- Our charitable tithes this Sunday will go to the [Saint Clare Home](#), which is a maternity home for unwed mothers right here in our own diocese. We're very happy to support his important outreach!
- Due to the penitential nature of Advent, there are no flowers in the sanctuary this Sunday.
- The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, December 8, is a Holy Day of Obligation. Our Masses on Monday, December 8, will be at 7:30 AM, 9:00 AM, 11:00 AM, and 7:00 PM. For those who wish to make (or renew) their Consecration to Jesus through Mary, please arrive five minutes before Mass. I'll call everyone up to Our Lady's statue for the personal consecrations.
- Confessions will follow all of the morning Masses of the Immaculate Conception (but not the 7:00 PM Mass).
- Due to the Holy Day of Obligation, please note that the daily schedule of our parish will be very different on December 8. There is no morning Rosary at the Holy Angels Columbarium, no Morning Prayer (Lauds), no Evening Prayer (Vespers), and no evening Stations of the Cross. Our only Adoration time will be from 12:00 PM – 2:15 PM.
- Our 7:00 PM evening Mass on the Immaculate Conception, December 8, is also our Anniversary Mass. The Mass will conclude with a solemn Crowning of Our Lady (the indoor statue) and a parish Consecration to Jesus through Mary. After the Mass, we'll have a Fellowship in the Parish Hall. I encourage all parishioners to make every effort to come to our Anniversary Mass!
- This Wednesday, December 10, at 10:30 AM we have the next gathering of our Eucharistic Kids! This is a monthly opportunity for small children and stay-home parents to adore the Eucharistic Lord and share in some playtime. All small children and their parents are invited!
- This coming Saturday, December 13, at 4:00 PM, we'll have Solemn Vespers with the Blessing of Eyes in honor of Saint Lucy. All are welcome!
