## Passion (Palm) Sunday

### March 29, 2026

- Our charitable tithe this Sunday will go to the Mercy Sisters of Saint Faustina, who are responsible for spreading the teachings and devotion of the Divine Mercy.
- This weekend, four young men from our parish attended the Seminary Visit at Saint Joseph's College in Louisiana. We pray for their discernment! These four are in addition to the three young men of our parish who are currently in the application process for the seminary. The process should end in early May.
- This Monday, March 30: The parish schedule remains the same. Since we are in Holy Week, our Noon Mass will be indoors. Father Nicholas Kramer will be offering the Mass and hearing Confessions in the afternoon. *Welcome back, Father Kramer!* There are no evening Stations of the Cross.
- Tuesday, March 31: There is no public Mass or Confessions at the parish. I'll be attending the Chrism Mass in Charleston with our Bishop. The parish schedule remains the same, except the Saint Peregrine Novena will be at 12 Noon and our afternoon Adoration is from 12:15 PM - 2:15 PM. The parish campus will close at 5:00 PM. All evening activities are suspended.
- Spy Wednesday, April 1: The parish schedule remains the same, except the parish campus and church will close at 5:00 PM. All evening activities are suspended.
- Holy Thursday, April 2: The parish campus and church will be open for personal prayer from 9:30 AM – 11:55 PM. There is no Noon Mass. All public devotionals and events are suspended. The Mass of the Lord's Supper is at 7:00 PM. Adoration and Confessions will be available after Mass until 11:55 PM.
- Good Friday, April 3: All regular activities are suspended. The parish campus and church are open for personal prayer from 8:30 AM – 6:00 PM. Confessions are from 9:00 AM – 2:30 PM. The Solemn Stations of the Cross are at 12 Noon. The Liturgy of the Lord's Passion is at 3:00 PM. Confessions are heard again from 4:30 PM – 6:00 PM.
- Holy Saturday, April 4: All regular activities are suspended. The parish campus is not open to the public until 8:00 PM. The Great Easter Vigil is at 8:30 PM. After the Mass, we have our annual Resurrection Party. All are welcome!
- Easter Sunday, April 5: The parish will have its regular Sunday Mass schedule: 7:30 AM, 9:00 AM, and 11:00 AM.
