Twenty-Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time

- The flowers in the sanctuary this Sunday are in honor of the 4th Wedding Anniversary of Tom and Linda Ruck. We wish them a very *Happy Anniversary!*
- This Sunday in the narthex, we have sign-ups for our Nocturnal Adoration this coming Friday-Saturday, October 2-3.
- This Sunday, after the 11:00 AM Mass, we'll have one of our periodic Fellowship Sundays.
- Our new "Fulton Sheen Organ" will be arriving tomorrow, Monday, September 28. The workers will need several days to install the organ and adjust our speakers and sound system. As such, we will need to slightly adjust our parish logistics and schedule.
- In particular, the Blessed Sacrament will be moved into a place of repose in the main sacristy for this coming week. Also, Rooms 1 and 2 of the Parish Hall will be temporarily transformed into "The Chapel."
- This Monday, September 28, Father Nicholas Kramer will offer our Noon Mass and hear Confessions after Mass. Confessions will be heard face-to-face in our Administrative Office, which will become a temporary "Reconciliation Room."
- This Tuesday and Wednesday, September 29 and 30, I'll be in local meetings that require my attendance. As such our Mass on Tuesday, September 29, will be at 5:15 PM and our Mass on Wednesday, September 30, will be at 12:15 PM. There will be no *morning Confessions* on these days.
- Confessions will be heard on Wednesday afternoon and Tuesday and Wednesday evening.
- We will not have faith formation on Wednesday evening. We will still have Vespers and OCIA on Wednesday evening.
- This Tuesday, September 29, from 1:00 PM - 2:45 PM, we'll have the first session of our Senior Game Day. All senior parishioners are invited to come for games and fellowship!
- Our First Weekend observances all remain the same this coming Friday and Saturday.
- This coming Saturday, October 3, we will observe the ancient Franciscan custom of the Transitus during Solemn Vespers at 4:00 PM. A Fellowship will follow Vespers.
